Helpful hints for parents


- Practise with the numbers in order **and** chosen randomly the aim is for your child to be able to respond immediately.
- Chanting tables really does help. Make it fun by adding actions too, or singing!
- Don't forget to chant those division facts too, they are often much harder to recall.
- •Look at the patterns with both objects and numbers e.g. as one number increases the other one decreases.

Key vocabulary add total how many more to make? altogether times multiplied by lots of groups of multiple of divided by shared double half

Six children have 3p each. How much will they have altogether?

Dice:

Roll two dice; find the total. Your child multiplies the total by 3. Can they also say the associated division fact?



18p!

How did you work that out? Six lots of 3 pence is 18p.
