

## Supporting Pack for QEGS Maths Transition Work

There are a number of poster resources on our class web page to remind you of the types of number mentioned on the task sheet. Your KS2 revision guides will also have pages about these number types if you've forgotten and need some extra practise!

### Idea:

I'd recommend cutting the headings and numbers out/writing them onto pieces of paper so that they can be moved around the grid until you get the right combination.

Here are the headings and number cards 1-25 to help you. You can print the grid off the task sheet to use alongside these or just draw it out!
