



Over the coming half term we have set a variety of home learning tasks for you to choose. These can be completed in any order from the selection below but some of the activities will not be covered until part way through the term so check with Mrs. Cooper if you're not sure which activities have been covered. Please collect evidence of your home learning in your home learning book, for example, writing, pictures or photographs of things you have made or internet research that has contributed to your work. We want you to be proud of your work so do your best work in all the tasks. Some of the tasks may take a couple of weeks. There are a range of smaller tasks to complete in the meantime as you will need to hand in a task **each week**.

*****Over the half term we would like you to complete: At least one of the LITERACY-based tasks and at least two of MATHS tasks*****

Whilst some of these activities are maths and literacy based, many are creative activities to enable your child to complete activities which allow them to use their preferred skills eg. art or music. These activities are designed to give you an opportunity to share in the learning with your child. However, this list is not entirely prescriptive and we do appreciate all the opportunities you share with your child. Therefore, any tasks you feel are relevant please add to the list.

Topic 1/Art and Design	Create your own firework/bonfire picture. This could be using collage, paint, crayon, felt pen, ict, chalks, pastels etc.			
Topic 2/PE	Practise travelling in different ways eg. hopping, walking, crawling, jumping, skipping. Use these to create a sequence. You could video this and either bring in or email to school.			
Topic 3/Literacy	Create winter/Christmas alliterative phrases e.g. tinsel tickled the tree, snow swirled softly.			
Topic 4/Computing	Use a painting programme to make your own Christmas/Winter card.			
Topic 5/British Values	Find out about how they celebrate Christmas in a different country.			
Science	Go on a listening walk outside and/or inside. Make a list of the different sounds you can hear.			
Science	Find/make some objects/pictures to do with winter and bring in the for the seasons table.			

RE 1	Create a poster for a Nativity Play.			
RE 2	Draw a place which you find peaceful. Y1 -Write a sentence explaining why this place is peaceful. Y2 - Write a short paragraph explaining why this place is peaceful.			
Literacy 1	Are you a SPAG specialist? Ask Mrs Cooper for a worksheet based on the week's SPAG learning. ** Ask your teacher for a worksheet for this one**			
Literacy 2	Y1 – Make a list of items to do with winter/Christmas. Y2 – Write a list sentence about Christmas/winter. Remember to use commas between each item but and between the last two items.			
Maths 1	Practise forming the numerals 0 -9 accurately. ** Ask your teacher for a worksheet for this one**			
Maths 2	Role play paying for items from a shop. E.g. an item costs 22p. What coins could we use to pay for this? (Y2 How many different ways could we pay for this item?)
