On Wednesday this week, Year 4 & 5 pupils travelled to QEGS to enjoy an afternoon of STEM activities. Year 7 and 9 STEM Ambassadors and Maths Masters led the session beginning with a short presentation about how Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths are all around us in our everyday lives.

bags in our foyer and bags can be brought in at any time, to be stored until the next collection.)


#### PTFA Meeting


