
There are seven aspects of early phonological awareness in Level 1. Each of these aspects is represented by one of Kit and Sam's toys.




Each Level 1 week pack includes 5 small group activity cards, 5 large group activity cards, a weekly plan and assessment sheets for the small group activities.

Aspect 1 General Sound Discrimination - Environmental Sounds

- · Develop listening skills and awareness of sounds in the environment
- · Identify and remember the differences between sounds
- · Talk about sounds in greater detail
