We will continue to learn
about how to keep ourselves
safe. We will also be learning
about how our bodies
change.

English

Class Reading and Comprehension:

Class reading book – Mr Penguin and
the Fortress of Secrets.

Also, Little Wandle Phonics guided
reading sessions. Children will also
have a Little Wandle reading book or
a book on Accelerated Reader to
read at home.

Writing:

Children will explore the non fiction
text and use technical vocabulary to
write their own reports about bugs
and bees.

SPAG:

Spelling Y2 and Y3 linked to phonics
and common exception words

Punctuation – full stops, commas and
question marks.

Grammar – Word classes,
conjunctions, expanded noun phrases
and writing in present tense.

Firstly we will be learning about non
fiction texts and writing our own non
chronological reports about bugs and
bees. We will then be looking at
books linked to looking after our
planet.
