English

Class Reading and Comprehension:

Whole school –The bear and the Piano. We will be orally retelling the story and using role play in the classroom.

Writing:

YR1 - We will be starting to use our phonic knowledge to write simple sentences. We will be saying our sentence out loud first to understand what we need to write.

YR2 – Building on last year to create sentences that use expanded nouns phrases. Also using this to create a story setting.

This will be based on a variety of texts mainly the trilogy of The Bear and the Piano.

Phonics: We will be starting Little Wandle phonics, this half term we will be recapping phase 2 and 3 sounds after doing a baseline assessment with the children within the first week.
