Reading: Your child is required to regularly read independently or with an adult. Little and often is key, as reading is the key to all learning! Reading 5 times per week is proven to have a positive impression on fluency and comprehension. Remember to question your children as they read to check they have understood what they have read.

Spellings: These are usually given out on a Friday. Children should practise regularly throughout the week with joined handwriting and look, cover write, check. Spellings will be tested on the following Friday. Spelling lists are adapted within each year group.

Times Tables: There will be a multiplication tests throughout the term to monitor progress. Please remind your child to practice 5-10 minutes per day on TTRS. The soundcheck mode is perfect for preparing for the end of year multiplication check (Y4).

Half Term Project: To be handed in on Wednesday 15th December

Choose one of the following projects:

- My Music Hero: Children will choose their favourite music artist or band and create a fun fact file and creative presentation to share what they've learned. Things to include: Artist's timeline, discography, favourite songs, short summative biography, fun facts
