In Otters ...

This half term we have been learning about our local area and comparing it with Tulum in Mexico. The children went for a local walk to identify human and physical features of Waterhouses. Additionally, Otters had World Cup Fever! The children were given a country in the world cup, they found their flag using an atlas, coloured it in and found out some different facts about their country. In design and technology, the children have created a moving monster toy. They explored levers, pivots and linkages and then they used their knowledge in order to attach them together and create their own monsters!



In Penguins ... This term, we have had the pleasure of using our Forest school for a variety of different fun activities! They have been using acrylic paints to paint their own beautiful scenes on pebbles and stones; making magic wands from the sticks they find in nature; and exploring our natural resources that we have in the forest area itself! The children love the area we have and it's great to see them exploring the nature we have!



In White Tigers...

They have been busy rehearsing our play – Mary Poppins. Y6 also took part in the Goblin challenge at Lichfield. They designed the cart and took part in the races at the racetrack. Penguins and White Tigers took part in a First Aid morning led by Mrs Harris, they learned about CPR, water safety and dealing with injuries such as breaks and sprains. As a school, we attended the Methodist Chapel with Rev Julie leading our service where she talked about moving onto new adventures and being salt in the world. Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo with black/grey trousers, skirt or shorts; white/pale blue polo shirt, shirt or blouse. In summer, shorts or a blue and white checked dress may be worn. Dark coloured appropriate school shoes are required (not trainers).

PE: Indoor - pale blue or white collarless t-shirt (with or without logo) and navy-blue shorts,
Outdoor - trainers and navy blue or black tracksuit/jogging bottoms and sweatshirt are recommended for colder weather.

Swimming: All in one plain swimsuit or fitted swimming trunks (not baggy beach shorts). No sequined items please. Swim caps must be worn. £4 from the school office
Reception has a full swimming programme. Nursery will have some taster sessions in the Summer Term.

Outdoor Forest Learning: Suitable outdoor clothing including waterproof jacket and trousers or splash suit and wellingtons/sturdy weatherproof footwear.

Earrings – only studs. These will need to be removed for swimming and PE.

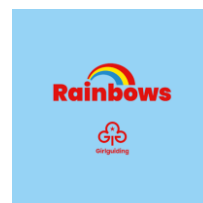
