Maths

Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division

Computing

Learners develop their understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices.

Geography

In this unit, children will review their knowledge about the seas and oceans that surround the UK, understanding that the UK is made up of a range of islands with an expansive coastline. Children will learn about coasts, how they can vary, and why. They will learn to identify different features of coasts and how they are formed. Children will learn about the physical processes that cause a coastline to change over time. Children will look at case studies of the UK's coastlines.

RE

How and why do people try to make the world a better place?

In this unit, pupils will find out about how Jewish, Christian, Muslim, and non-religious people try to care for the world.

French

Expressing likes and saying what I and others do

PSHE

Children will learn they have rights and how these benefit them and adults' roles in supporting children's rights. We will look at different groups within the local community and how they use local buildings and how charities support the local community.

Class Writing Book - Flotsam

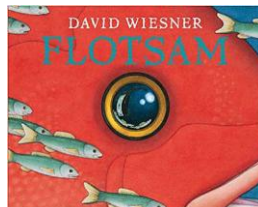
Children will explore the fictional text of Flotsam to write their own persuasive letter, short story, non-fiction fact file and an advert.

Spelling: This year, children will be set spellings each week with a focus on their year group spelling rules. Spelling shed will be used to help children to learn their spellings and practice them as homework.

Punctuation: Full stops, commas, question marks, speech marks and exclamation marks, semi colons and colons.

Grammar: Using conjunctions – coordinating and subordinating; expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and a thesaurus accurately.

Flotsam written by Dave Wiesner is a wordless picture book centred around plastic pollution and the effects it has on sea life. A young boy is down at the beach, examining all the flotsam. Bottles, lost toys, cans and many different types of pollution. During his adventure, he's lucky enough to discover an underwater camera! This camera, however, has its own secrets.

Cooking: Come Dine with Me

In this unit, the children will be planning and cooking their own three course meal for each other.

Science

You could even have an egg the other side of your defence that you must protect.
